

MYC J22 September Series Milford Yacht Club Sept 5, 12, 19, 26, 2023

Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located online at milfordyachtclub.com
- 2.2 Notices to competitors can be delivered orally prior to departure from the harbor.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1200 on the day it will take effect.
- 3.2 Changes to the sailing instruction may be made on the water by hailing each individual skipper and receipt of acknowledgement from each skipper.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the race committee boat while at dock.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 Races are scheduled for 4 Tuesday evenings- Sept 5- 12- 19- 26, 2023.
- 5.2 The first warning signal will be 1730 each evening.
- 5.3 Multiple races are scheduled each evening limited by returning to dock prior to sunset.

6 COURSES

Courses and marks will be hailed prior to the warning signal. (See Appendix A).

7 THE START

- 7.1 Appendix U replaces RRS 26.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race Committee vessel and the course side of the nearby starting mark

8 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

Any change of course will be made by hailing; the next mark need not be in place at that time.

9 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee boat and the course side of the nearby finishing mark.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

11 TIME LIMITS

- 11.1 The time limit for the first boat to start, sail the course and finish shall be 45 minutes
- 11.2 The time limit for boats to finish after the first boat starts, sails the course and finishes shall be 6 minutes. (Finishing Window)
- 11.3 Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window shall be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1 and A5.2.
- 11.4 The race may be abandoned if it is apparent that no boat will be able to finish in the time limit

12 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 12.1 Hearing request forms will be available from the race committee.
- 12.2 Protests and request for redress shall be delivered to the race committee within 60 minutes of RC boat docking
